

Club Pattern Challenge

We would like to put together a binder of sets of patterns that we would use at our Regional Show each year. To accomplish this, we would like to challenge clubs or senior members to put together one set of patterns (as listed below) that could potentially be used at our Regional Show. A committee will get together and go through all submitted patterns and make minor changes if necessary and then approve them for use. We hope this will help alleviate a lot of the problems we have had with patterns in the past.

Things to keep in mind:

1. The patterns cannot be too long.
2. They must follow the levels.
3. They should be simple but challenging.
4. They cannot conflict with our show rules. Make sure you read them, especially for trail obstacles.
5. When doing trail patterns, the set up of objects needs to stay the same for all the levels in that ring, the members will just do them differently.
6. In-Hand and Young Horse will need to be done with both the Level 1-3 patterns and with the Level 4-7 patterns as we will not know what ring they will be in until we have numbers each year.

We will need patterns for the following classes:

1. Level 1-2 Showmanship
2. Level 3 Showmanship
3. Level 4 Showmanship
4. Level 5 Showmanship
5. Level 6-7 Showmanship
6. Level 1-2 Horsemanship
7. Level 3 Horsemanship
8. Level 4 Horsemanship (Junior Horse will also use this pattern)
9. Level 5 Horsemanship
10. Level 6-7 Horsemanship
11. Yearling In-hand Trail (one set for the Level 1-3 ring and one set for the Level 4-7 ring)
12. Two Year Old In Hand Trail (one set for the Level 1-3 ring and one set for the Level 4-7 ring)
13. Level 1-2 Trail
14. Level 3 Trail
15. Level 4 Trail
16. Level 5 Trail
17. Level 6-7 Trail
18. Young Horse Trail Level 4 (one set for the Level 1-3 ring and one set for the Level 4-7 ring)
19. Young Horse Trail Level 5-7 (one set for the Level 1-3 ring and one set for the Level 4-7 ring)
