4-H On Parade Regional Beef Female Show Rules

Revised: February, 2011

- 1) Two classes per age category will be available:
 - Purebred & Fullblood (As designated by breed association)
 - Commercial (animal without papers).
- 2) For each breed, there must be eight (8) animals per breed to form show classes. If not, animals of that registered breed will be shown in the "All Other Breeds" category. Any class changes are at the discretion of the Regional Beef Female Show Committee.
- 3) All Purebred and Fullblood animals must be identified by tattoo as recorded on breed registration papers. All animals must be identified by a locked CCIA ear tag.
- 4) As Alberta has been declared Brucellosis free, no Brucellosis testing will be necessary for the show.
- 5) All animals to be shown in this show are 4-H project animals and must be registered with the Regional 4-H Office by **December 31st, 2010**. (For example: in the 1997-98 4-H year, they must be registered by December 1st, 1997.) Before **April 15th, 2011**, a yearling heifer may be replaced, if a death certificate or a veterinarian certificate is presented to the club leader, and the club leader then applies to the Regional 4-H Beef Female Committee for approval. The replacement heifer need not have been registered with the Regional 4-H Office previously, nor be of the same breed or show category as the replaced heifer. Registration papers for a replacement Purebred or Fullblood heifer must be submitted to the 4-H on Parade Beef Female Committee by **April 30th, 2011**.
- 6) Unruly heifers may be changed before **February 15th, 2011** upon discretion of the 4-H Leader and the Regional Beef Female Show Committee Chairman.
- 7) Members showing replacement heifers are not eligible to place higher than 3rd in their conformation class, but are still eligible to advance in Showmanship.
- 8) Early pregnancy in a yearling heifer is **not** a suitable reason for replacement.
- 9) A heifer is eligible to show as a 2 or 3-year-old as long as the heifer was registered by **December 31st** as a 4-H yearling project in the member's name. A qualifying yearling heifer 4-H project that is unable to show as a yearling, can be brought back to show as a two or three-year-old by the club member in whose name she was originally registered.
- 10) All members' 4-H heifer project's registration papers must be in the member's name or the parent's or family's company or herd name.
- 11) Any problems arising at 4-H on Parade will be dealt with at the Regional Beef Female Show Committee's discretion. Any decision rendered by the Regional Beef Female Show Committee shall be final.

- 12) Each project requires a \$10.00 **non-refundable** entry fee by April 1st, 2011, accompanied by its breed registration paper (if applicable).
- 13) Cancellation date is the April 18th, 2011 4-H on Parade meeting.
- 14) Show order shall be determined by rotation of the breeds each year and two breeds will alternate age classes. Entries shall be catalogued and will enter the ring from youngest to oldest. Purebred and Crossbred animals will show in separate rings, concurrently.
- 15) The Committee will apply a non-4-H member "Hands Off" ruling. Non-4-H members may lead or hold an animal but are asked to refrain from washing, brushing, clipping, fitting, etc. during 4-H on Parade.
- 16) The Regional Beef Female Show Committee reserves the right to excuse an unruly animal, or any animal deemed unsuitable for show, at any time during 4-H On Parade.
- 17) "Grafted" (adopted) calves must be identified and the cow/grafted-calf pair will only be eligible for showmanship awards.
- 18) Member Project Herd consists of an animal from each class (heifer, 2-year-old cow/calf & 3-year-old cow calf). Each project must be registered with the Regional 4-H Office on **December 31st, 2010**. There are no additional fees to enter the Project Herd class.
- 19) Each calf shown as part of a 2-year-old or 3-year-old Cow/Calf pair must be a calendar year calf, meaning born in 2011.
- 20) Members will be evaluated to advance to their respective Showmanship Championship with each of their entries. If the Showmanship Judge believes a member should have the choice of which animal they take into their Showmanship Championship, the member must have been 'qualified' by the judge with each project in the show; therefore, each member must show in the Showmanship Championship with an entry in which the Judge determined that they qualified with. If a member qualifies with a 2-year-old or 3-year-old cow/calf pair project, the calf is NOT eligible to be shown in the Showmanship Championship. Further, if the member is showing the calf in the 2-year-old or 3-year-old cow/calf pair class, they are NOT eligible to be selected to advance in showmanship for that class.
- 21) A purebred cow with a commercial calf will be entered and show in the appropriate Commercial female class.
- 22) Clubs entering after the April 1st, 2011 deadline will be subject to a two hundred dollar (\$200) late registration fee. This is standard 4-H On Parade policy.
- 23) In situations for which the Regional Beef Female Committee does not have a rule, they will default to the Provincial 4-H Beef Heifer Show rules/standards/procedures/practices.

All member age divisions as of January 1st, 2011 -

Junior (J): 9 - 11 years (born in 1999, 2000 and 2001)

Intermediate (I): 12 - 14 years (born in 1996, 1997 and 1998)

Senior (S): 15 - 20 years (born in 1990, 1991, 1992, 1993, 1994 and 1995)
