

Steer Team Grooming

1. A maximum of three (3) teams may be entered from each 4-H club. **Senior Team** = three (3) senior members aged 15-20 (born between January 1st, 1990 and December 31st, 1995), **Intermediate Team** = three (3) Intermediate members aged 12-14 (born between January 1st, 1996 and January 31st, 1998), **Junior Team** = three (3) Junior members aged 9-11 (born between January 1st, 1999 and December 31st, 2001). All ages are as of January 1st, 2011. Awards will be provided for Junior, Intermediate and Senior teams.
2. The animal used must be entered in one of the regular classes in the show (i.e. Steer Show).
3. Each team entered is expected to provide one suitable 4-H animal. Animals may be switched among the teams at the beginning of the contest, at the discretion of the Judges and Show Committee. Thus a team may not necessarily be working on a steer that they have supplied.
4. The animal may be pre-clipped. There will be **no** pre-fitting of any kind prior to entering the preparation area.
5. Grooming equipment, including blocking chutes, will be allowed in the preparation area.
6. Parents and 4-H Leaders will not be allowed in the preparation area during the competition, and coaching from the sidelines will result in disqualification of the club entry.
7. Each team will have 20 minutes to prepare their steer. The Judge(s) will be observing the procedure.
8. After 20 minutes the entries will parade in the ring and the Judge(s) will determine the placings.
