## REGIONAL BEEF SHOW GENERAL RULES

All of the Northwest Regional Beef Regulations will be followed and in effect. Rules are available from the 4-H office. **YOUR ENTRY FEE MUST ACCOMPANY YOUR SHOW ENTRY**

1. **All 4-H members and clubs** are to participate in the **Formal Welcome 9:00 am Saturday**.
2. All animals **MUST** have a halter and a neck rope. Leaders/Parent Volunteers are required to check for neck ropes at night. Should livestock not have a neck rope, one will be provided, and the club will be billed for the cost. (\$25) **All cattle, including calves, require neck ropes!**
3. All 4-H members are encouraged to bring grooming chutes, clippers and blowers. An area will be designated for grooming chutes.
4. All members entered in the Northwest Regional Show must be members in good standing with their club and have fulfilled all project requirements.
5. All projects are judged equally. Club and district placing have no influence at this show.
6. Unruly animals will be stalled in a safe area. The member will be given a second chance to show they can control the animal. If at this time the animal is deemed to be dangerous, the member will be asked to take it from show premises. The final decision will be left to the Northwest Regional Beef Show committee.
7. **Showmanship (Dry Brush Show)**: Open to all 4-H members in the Northwest, Northeast, West Central and East Central Regions. Members must pre-register by entry deadline. Members are responsible for finding an animal to show (it may be one of their projects) and providing show equipment. Grooming will not be taken into consideration of your placing.
8. Showmanship classes are based on member's age as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of current year. All members must be in the staging area prior to their class and prepared to show. If you miss your class, you forfeit the opportunity to show in the class. **REMINDER: Proper and polite show etiquette must be exhibited at all times.**
9. **NO PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT WILL BE TOLERATED**, except when member and/or animal safety is an issue.
10. All feed and tack must be stored in designated areas, as assigned by Show Committee.
11. Stalls, aisles, wash rack and common areas must be kept neat and clean at all times.
12. *Grievance Procedure*: Should there be a grievance, it must be submitted in writing, with \$25.00 to the show office. The Northwest Show Committee will then meet to review the grievance. Should the grievance be upheld, the money will be refunded to the complainant.

**NOTE: ALL CLUBS PARTICIPATING IN THE BEEF SHOW MUST PROVIDE ONE PARENT/LEADER OR MEMBER TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR SHOW RING AND MARSHALLING AREA CLEANLINESS DURING THE SHOW.**

## FRESHMAN CLASS RULES

Open to members exhibiting a beef project at FOCUS for the first time. **This is a Dry Brush Show**

The class will be evaluated in the following manner: 40% - Showmanship 60% - Conformation

## TEAM GROOMING RULES

1. Team Grooming will consist of two (2) or three (3) members; the members may choose any partner but must enter in the class according to age of the oldest competitor. Individuals entering will be assigned a partner and/or a team
2. Members must supply an animal for the competition that is CLEAN.
3. Grooming area must be clean prior to each competition and participants must be on time. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.
4. Each team will be allowed an additional member to assist with bringing equipment to the grooming area.
5. Competitors will be given 20 minutes. Judging criteria will consist of knowledge, teamwork and final product.

The 2011 Northwest Regional 4-H Beef Record Book awards will be presented at the supper on Friday evening.

## BEEF AGGREGATE

It is the hope of the NW Regional Beef Heifer Show Committee that the members will participate in as many events as possible. To encourage this, the Beef Aggregate Awards are the most important awards of the entire program. Junior, Intermediate and Senior Aggregate winners will be recognized. A Junior and Senior Aggregate winner may be eligible to compete at the 2011 Western Canadian All Breeds Competition at Bashaw, Alberta in August.
