Items will be evaluated starting at 10:30 am on Saturday. The display will be presented for your enjoyment both Saturday and Sunday until 5:00 pm. Please fill in the Exhibit Tags prior to bringing article to Bench Show.

RULES AND EXPECTATIONS

Carefully read and follow guidelines. Note instructions for presentation. Entries not complying may be disqualified.

1. Only Life Skills Members may enter the bench show. Life skills projects include Crafts, Scrapbooking, Foods, Clothing, Small Engine, Photography, Gardening, Woodworking and Computer. All other projects may have displays.
2. Entries must be your own 4-H project made in the current 4-H year (2010-2011).
3. Deliver all entries between 10:00 am and 10:30 am, Saturday July 9, 2011. Late entries will not be accepted.
4. Entries are to be clean, neat and presentable.
5. The 4-H system of judging will be used. All projects awarded 10, 9 or 8 points – first. Projects awarded 7, 6 or 5 points – second. Projects awarded 4, 3 or 2 points – third. Judges decision is final.
6. Only one entry per member per class, a member may enter a maximum of three classes.
7. Exhibit tags are sent with the Focus on 4-H entry form prior to the show. Photocopy if more tags are needed. Fill in the tag, checking class number and details, and securely attached to the entry.
8. Members supply their own containers or plates where necessary.
9. Projects may not be removed before 5:00 pm July 10, 2011. Members are responsible for picking up their projects at this time. Sponsor gifts will be presented to each exhibitor at this time.
10. Age divisions are age as of January 1, 2011
Junior 9 to 11 years Intermediate 12 to 14 years Senior 15 to 20 years
11. Focus on 4-H will not be responsible for breakage or loss of projects.
12. Foods: All baking must be from scratch. NO MIXES ALLOWED. Display baking on paper plates or foil covered cardboard. All baking, except iced cakes, must be wrapped in plastic.
13. Photography: All photographs must be mounted.

Thank you for participating in the Focus on 4-H Life skills Bench Show. Please be open-minded. Great satisfaction can be derived from showing your work. Take this opportunity to share and show off what you have learned in 4-H this year. Here is a chance to promote 4-H to others. We know you will have fun.
