

QUICK REFERENCE - SWINE TRACEABILITY REGULATION

The Swine Traceability Regulation under the *Animal Health Act* requires applicable parties (e.g. shippers, transporters or receivers) to record and report movements of swine, including deadstock, within, into and out of Alberta.

June 2014 amendments included:

- 1) Reporting has expanded to incorporate all movements, rather than only farm-to-slaughter; and
- 2) The regulation also applies to deadstock.
