Construction or upgrade of a surface water management system

- Run-on and Runoff control
- Surface water flow within the facility

### **403 PEN RENOVATION**

Pen renovations to meet AOPA standards

- For operations that existed prior to 2002
- Engineering fees
- Earthwork
- Old facility removal

### **404 MANURE STORAGE**

Eliminate the need for winter spreading Relocation of a poor facility

- Engineering costs
- Concrete/ steel/earthwork
- Decommissioning of old storages



### **405 CFO RELOCATION**

CFO relocation to address risk to water

- Decommission of old site
- Engineering
- Earthwork



## **406 SOLID/LIQUID SEPARATION**

Reduction in volume of manure to be transported 3 projects


### **407 COMPOSTING**

- Road crossings

### **REGULATORY RESPONSIBILITY**

- Applicant is responsible for all permits NRCB, AENV, municipal
- Grandfathered operations requiring a permit
  - NRCB assess the risk associated with existing facilities.
  - risks needs to be addressed but do not necessarily have to meet AOPA standards.
  - NRCB will work with operator to address improvements in a time frame that works for the producer


