POLICY STATEMENT

Brazeau County carries out education on beaver control in order to minimize damage to agricultural land, trees and shelterbelts and other agricultural concerns. The County carries out beaver control that affects County roads.

POLICY

Landowners are encouraged to minimize beaver problems on their land and to assist adjacent landowners in alleviating beaver problems, also it is the opinion of the Agricultural Service Board that beaver on private land are primarily the landowner's responsibility to control.

In addition, no work will be conducted for resource companies.

Requests for dam removal on lands under the management, operation and control of Brazeau County will not be charged if the dam in question is adversely affecting cultivated land, private grazing land or residential dwellings.

Priorization of Work

The Fieldman's office will notify Public Works of any flooding of public roads.
