

VEGETATION MANAGEMENT
ROADSIDE SPRAYING

OBJECTIVE: To control noxious weeds that grow along County right-of-ways.

1. The County will hire a Certified Applicator to run the sprayer.
2. The applicator must hold a valid Applicator's Certificate for the required classes.
3. The County will spray any Municipal road allowance as deemed necessary with minimum off target application.
4. All numbered Highways will be first priority.
5. The spray program will be advertised in April of every year.
6. Landowners who do not wish to have the right-of-ways sprayed along their property must post "Do Not Spray" signs far enough in advance to allow the operator enough time to react.
7. Do Not Spray signs will be available at the County Office.
8. The County will use a selective systemic herbicide to control any noxious weeds that are growing along the road allowances.
9. Sprayer operators will only spray when the weather and wind conditions warrant and will keep an accurate daily log of roads sprayed, wind and weather conditions.
10. The Roadside Spraying Program and the Roadside Mowing Program will be coordinated so that they are not duplicating their efforts.
