Title: Weed & Brush Control - Roadside Spraying 60.63.01

Policy Statement: Municipal road ditches including secondary highways will be sprayed with herbicide to control restricted, noxious and nuisance weeds.

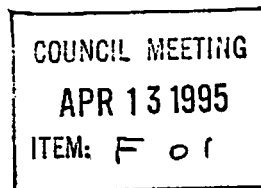
Purpose: To prevent the spread of weeds from roadside ditches to agricultural land and to control brush regrowth in ditches where the roads have been regraded or the brush has been removed.

Procedure: The Agricultural Fieldman/Assistant Agricultural Fieldman will determine which roadside ditches should be sprayed in the upcoming season and map these areas for the spray crew.

Notice of commencement of the spaying operation will be advertised in local newspapers. Landholders who refuse to allow spraying of the right-of-way adjacent to their property will be asked to control the weeds and brush on that portion of right-of-way at their own expense. An agreement stating that the landowner accepts responsibility for the control of weeds and brush must be signed by all landholders who wish to control the same at their own expense. Failure to fulfil that agreement to the satisfaction of the Agricultural Service Board may result in appropriate action being taken to control the weeds and brush.
