# **RESOL. NO. 61/09**

MOVED approval of the following Clubroot Policy:

OBJECTIVE: TO PREVENT THE ESTABLISHMENT AND SPREAD OF CLUBROOT WITHIN THE COUNTY OF FORTY MILE NO. 8 AND PERFORM ENFORCEMENT AS REQUIRED BY THE AGRICULTURAL PESTS ACT.

- 1. Random field inspections will be performed by inspectors appointed by the County of Forty Mile No. 8 under the Agricultural Pests Act.
- 2. Inspectors shall receive the necessary training required to properly identify Clubroot of Canola, Mustard or other cruciferous crops.
- 3. When the inspector is of the opinion that a field is infested with Clubroot a sample shall be sent for a laboratory test.
- Upon laboratory confirmation of Clubroot infesting a field, the inspector shall issue Form 2

   Notice to Control Pests pursuant to Schedule 1 of the Pest and Nuisance Control Regulation.
- 5. The Notice to Control Pests shall include the following requirements:
  - i) Landowner must follow the Clubroot Management Plan developed by Alberta Agriculture and Rural Development,
  - ii) Landowner shall not plant or allow to be planted Canola, Mustard or other cruciferous crops for four (4) growing seasons from the issuance of the notice.
  - iii) Landowner must follow proper sanitation practices as outlined in the Management Plan.
- 6. The landowner may appeal the *Notice to Control Pests* to the Municipal Secretary within 10 days of the issuance of the notice.
- 7. If the Agricultural Fieldman is of the opinion that a landowner is not complying with the *Notice to Control Pests* and has planted Canola, Mustard, or other cruciferous crop within the four growing season period of the *Notice* being issued, then, the Agricultural Fieldman shall re-issue the *Notice to Control Pests* with the following stipulations:

- i) Landowner must destroy the crop by tillage, chemical or other means within 14 days of issuance of the notice.
- ii) Landowner shall not plant, or allow to be planted, Canola, Mustard or other cruciferous crops for the remainder of the period set out in the original notice.
- 8. Failure to comply with the *Notice to Control Pests* shall result in the Agricultural Fieldman destroying the Canola, Mustard or other cruciferous crop identified in the *Notice*, using methods described in the *Notice* and consistent with good agricultural practices.
- 9. All landowners and tenants adjacent to the lands infested with Clubroot shall be notified of the pest.
- 10. County rental equipment will not be rented for use on land that has tested positive for Clubroot within the previous four years.
