Procedure Statements:

- 1. The Public Works Department will annually prepare and submit to the Agricultural Fieldman a map and summary indicating all the previous year's road construction, brushing and back sloping.
- 2. A meeting between the Agricultural Fieldman and the Public Works Manager shall take place each year prior to budget consideration and at this time recommendations for the next year's budget shall be made.
- 3. The Agricultural Fieldman shall implement a brush-spraying program along roadsides in accordance with and to the extent permitted by budget allowances.
- 4. The Agricultural Fieldman will arrange for the spraying of brush alongside roadsides as required.
- 5. Registered herbicides are approved for brush control by the Agricultural Service Board will be used.
- 6. Only trees one half (0.5) to three (3) meters in height will be sprayed. Trees of height greater than three (3) meters or in sensitive areas must be removed by other methods such as mechanical brushing.
- 7. Chemical brush control will not take place within 30 meters of water bodies.
- 8. Weed infestations are placed in higher priority than brush control.
- 9. Residents shall be notified by newspaper prior to the start of the spraying program each year.
