## Purpose:

The broadcast seeding of grass and/or legume mixtures onto freshly backsloped roadsides, newly constructed roads, and borrow pits for the purposes of ground stabilization and weed control.

## Definitions:

"Borrow Pit" – an excavation dug to provide fill to make up ground elsewhere.

**Policy Statement:** 

- 1. The Agricultural Service Board will undertake a program of seeding grass and/or legume mixtures onto freshly backsloped, or newly constructed roads and borrow pits.
- 2. Camrose County Public Works will supply the locations, and if special varieties are required within specific areas to the Agricultural Service Board during the year of construction.
- 3. The Agricultural Fieldman, at his discretion, may supply an appropriate amount of grass seed to landowners wishing to seed borrow pits and roadsides on their own.
