processing, durable and non-durable goods, aviation and aerospace, oilfield equipment, and military service. The variety of his background, and his combination of technical and soft skills, give him the broad perspective needed to fully apply both organizational and engineering solutions to lean manufacturing and other productivity improvement efforts. Kaizen, the Japanese term for continuous improvement, focuses on making improvements by surfacing hidden problems, finding solutions for them through empowered team work, and streamlining processes to make the process self regulated, efficient and effective. The Kaizen event is an important tool for making large, rapid improvements in an operation, and is a key part of any lean program.

This one-day, hands-on workshop will give participants practice running a successful event. Based in a manufacturing facility, participants will be introduced to the principles of Kaizen, then break into groups to study an actual production process. After reviewing the current state, participants will devise improved methods, and then implement them on the plant floor. This will give everyone first-hand experience using a tool that can be immediately applied in their own operations.
