

What is the 4-H Hall of Fame?

The 4-H Hall of Fame honours Albertans who have made outstanding contributions to the 4-H program in this province.

Who can be nominated?

Alberta Agriculture and Rural Development invites the 4-H community to submit nominees for the Alberta 4-H Hall of Fame. The 4-H Hall of Fame honours Albertans who have made outstanding contributions to the 4-H program in this province. Albertans who have demonstrated significant initiative, leadership and a positive impact on 4-H will be chosen to join the other men and women who have been honored since the award was initiated in 1971. A nominee should have impact and achievements at the local, district, regional and provincial level.

Nominees may have served the 4-H program as volunteers or professionals. Their responsibilities and impact on 4-H as well as involvement in other community organizations and activities will be taken into consideration. Albertans chosen for induction into the Alberta 4-H Hall of Fame will be honoured at a banquet and ceremony in January during the annual Alberta 4-H Leaders conference. A maximum of two inductees will be honoured in a specific year.

A selection committee, made up of 4-H staff, Alberta 4-H Council members, and 4-H Foundation Directors will make a recommendation to the 4-H and Agriculture Education Branch head who will forward the choices to senior department officials. The Minister responsible for 4-H will make the official announcement during National 4-H month (November).

Groups or individuals are invited to submit nominations up to July 15 of the current year. Under no circumstances will late applications be accepted. Application forms are available from any 4-H staff member or can be downloaded from the 4-H website.

How to apply:

Complete all five sections of the nomination form:

- 1. Nominee and Nomination Information**
- 2. Introduction to Nominee**
- 3. 4-H Involvement**
- 4. Other Community Involvement**
- 5. Letters of Support:**
 - **three letters of support from individuals who have worked with the nominee in the Alberta 4-H program.** The letters of support must be signed or verified that they came from the originator.
 - **one letter of support from an individual who has worked with the nominee in another volunteer organization.** The letter of support must be signed or verified that it came from the originator.
 - **one letter of support from the nominee's district 4-H council.**
 - **one letter of support from the nominee's regional 4-H council.**

The selection committee **will not** consider an incomplete application.

- When completing the form, outline the nominee's qualifications briefly and avoid repetition. **Do not** include photos or news clippings.
