

## 4-H Tire Recycling Frequently Asked Questions.

### How does my club get involved?

Contact the 4-H Foundation of Alberta to register. Upon registering the 4-H Foundation of Alberta will contact your local landfill to let them know about the project, we will also send the information package complete with drop off location and collection forms. Clubs must register each collection season. Contact (780) 682-2153 or 1-877-682-2153 or email [susann.stone@4hab.com](mailto:susann.stone@4hab.com)

### When does the project run?

**October 1 - November 30.** Completed Forms, Unused forms and evaluation to be post marked Nov 30, 2008 to the 4-H Foundation of Alberta.

### How important are the forms?

VERY important! Filling out the forms correctly not only speeds up the payment but allows Alberta Recycling to have the appropriate paper work for accounting purposes. A random verification check on individuals that you picked up tires from is done prior to payment. A club representative signing for individuals is not allowed. If forms are not filled out correctly you will have to do it at a later date and that will delay your payment by months.



### Can the General public drop tires off at the landfill and say they are for 4-H?

NO, the general public will have to pay to drop off their tires at the landfills. Every tire that is classified by 4-H must be dropped off by a 4-H family with the correct paper work.

### When will our club receive funding for the tires that we collected?

Clubs are to post mark all tire collection forms in the mail Nov. 30, 2008 from the period of Oct 1-Nov 30, 2008. Forms received without a post marked date of Nov 30, 2008 will not be accepted.

### Can we collect tires from businesses that sell tires or landfills?

Businesses that sell tires and wish to have their tires picked up by a 4-H club must be passed by the Alberta Recycling Management Authority prior to pick up. Have the business contact the 4-H Foundation of Alberta at 1-877-682-2153 and indicate where they are from and the club that they wish their tires to go to. Cleaning up of landfills is prohibited.

### Can tires be taken to the landfills outside of the designated months?

Tire must be only dropped off with the appropriate paper work during the designated months. The designated days are set up to assist the smaller landfills with handling the tires.

### Why does our club have to register each season?

Every club that would like to participate has to register each season for the following reasons.

1. Updated tire collection forms will be sent out to your club.
2. Contact with the landfills of participating clubs is made. Only registered clubs local landfill will be contacted.
3. To ensure any changes to the program are passed on to the clubs
4. To ensure tires are taken in on designated dates only.

### Can the community drop tires off in a pile at a 4-H members farm?

NO, You must have a tire collection form for each individual that you collect tires from. Your club can have a designated drop off point or collection point prior to taking them to the landfill but it must be manned.

### Is the tire recycling fundraiser worth while for our club?

Your club should never say that they can't take part in an activity because they are short of funds if they have not tried tire recycling. It's dirty but well worth the work! Tire recycling also teaches members how to engage the public and the importance of paperwork.
