Alberta 4-H Presenters in Top Form



Red Deer – On April 12, 2008, 14 teams, representing all seven Alberta 4-H regions, competed in the 6th annual Provincial 4-H Presentations Finals. Title sponsored by AltaLink and cosponsored by Agrium and the Calgary Stampede, the provincial finals saw 24 individuals participate at the premier event for 4-H presentations competitions.

Participants of the event were required to give either an 8 to 10 minute demonstration or illustrated talk on the topic of their choice. "I was so impressed with the quality of the presentations the 4-H members delivered. It is a testament to the hard work, practice and dedication that goes into preparing for this competition," commented presentation judge Robin Boschman. "4-H members truly come out of this program with an advantage - the public speaking and presenting skills they learn and hone are a highly sought-after commodity."

Top honours for the event went to Amanda High (Fort MacLeod) and Emily Puch (Pincher Creek) of the South Country Judging 4-H Club for their presentation "What goes in...must come out!". Second place went to T.J. Fenton (Lamont) from the Lamont 4-H Beef Club for his "Garnishing" demonstration while Danielle Dornbusch (Alberta Beach) and Hilary McKee (Darwell) from the Lobstick 4-H Beef & Multi Club took home third place with their topic "A Herbal Solution".

While the presentations program is relatively new it has not taken 4-Her's long to refine the art of successfully presenting to a large audience. "This year's competitors amazed me with all the new and innovative ideas they brought forward," stated 2007 presentations winner and this year's emcee, Allison Eisenreich. "Every year the presentations program gets better and better."
