Based only on 4-H involvement and contribution. Based only on the information provided by the nominees on this form. Mail to: 4-H Office, Mailbag 600, Stettler, AB T0C 2L0.

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION:

This form must be in the 4-H Office, Stettler by 4:30pm, December 1st of the current year.

Presentation will be made at the East Central Regional Leader Recognition Night.

TERM OF APPLICATION:

This form will be kept on file for 3 years and reviewed annually. Nominators have the right to update information should your volunteer not be selected this year.

APPLICATION:

Each year a number of volunteers are not accepted simply because the information is not complete enough. We know that they've done more but the selection committee uses only what is written. Please be as complete as possible.
