



**CALGARY 4-H REGION 4-H LEADER OR 4-H ALUMNI MEMBER
SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM**



Eligibility:

1. Applicant must be a 4-H leader or 4-H alumni member in the Calgary 4-H Region for three years with one year immediately preceding the application.
2. Applicant must be 18 years or older and cannot be currently registered as a 4-H member.
3. Applicant must supply proof of attendance at a post-secondary institution (university, college, vocational school, etc). Apprenticeship programs are eligible. Attach verification of apprenticeship program.
4. Applicant's program of study can be in any field and they may apply in any year of their program.
5. One scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 will be awarded each year and may only be awarded once to any individual.
6. Scholarship will be awarded in the second semester of study (January) or at the end of the first year of apprenticeship.
