4-H camps provide the opportunity for members to develop skills, engage in skill sessions (archery, crafts, canoeing (where applicable), dance, etc.), meet new and old friends and play during camp activities (campfire, wide games, talent show, beachfront, dance, etc.). Intermediate delegates will have increased choice in the activities and the opportunity to plan activities. At 6-day Intermediate Camp delegates may also participate in an overnigher at the teepees. We strive to provide a positive camp environment where delegates feel free to be themselves and help delegates to reach his or her potential. The 4-H Camping Program is a great place to go!

All camps located at the Alberta 4-H Centre welcome a maximum of 80 delegates per camp, with the exception of Junior Camp 2 and Combined Camp 3, which both have a maximum of 40 delegates. Priority is given to 4-H campers who have never attended a camp, and those whose applications are received prior to the deadline.

**Junior Camp** is for members between 9 and 11 years of age. A 12-year-old attending camp for the first time with a younger sibling is also welcome.

**Combined Camp** is for members between 10 and 13 years of age. 10 and 11 year olds must have attended a previous 4-H camp, or have an older sibling attending this camp.

**Intermediate Camp** is for members aged 12 to 14. 12-year-old campers should have previously attended a 4-H camp.
