Rules changes or amendments for 2009

Introduction

Page 2 #7 Entry fees \$5.00 number charge for each member/Horse combination

Page 2 #8 Stall Fees New motion Jan 90 meeting - as pertaining to motion made at this meeting regarding 2<sup>nd</sup> project animal. All members will be allotted one stall and a 2<sup>nd</sup> stall will be allotted on the basis of availability and PAID entries are received. A record book must be done on the other animal and it is the responsibility of the leader that this done and the leader must sign the entry form.

### **Rules and Regulations Section**

Page 1 A-16 Each member is allowed only two horses, one being their main project horse, according to 4-H rules, which must be entered in 50% of the events and both horses must have a record book done on each horse.

Page 10-11 O-2 Tack Slid on spurs are prohibited equipment for safety reasons. Not allowed in any classes.

Page 8 N-2 Tack Kimberwicks are prohibited equipment in Dressage.

Page 10 #8 Dressage-Kimberwicks not allowed in Dressage Motion made in August 08 meeting. We need new tests and we have some, but for free style there are no new ones available.

Page 13 R-2 Dress code Must have long sleeves and a collar. No baseball caps, T-shirts and or tank tops. Must wear club uniform until barrels and poles on Tuesday.

Members must done events before the show. This is not the place to try new things.

Please encourage members and parents to fill out evaluations.

English pads must be white or off white, crazy or funky colored ones, are not proper show attire.

Discussion on keeping the Maiden Class, does it have any merit? Most agreed that the younger children love it.

Showmanship is a mandatory class. If member(s) do not go in the class the disciplinary committee will deal with the individual, whether it will be to take away a class for example, poles or barrels or give them a bathroom duty.

Maybe add Big T or the Ribbon Race to list of classes. Big T is an alternate class for any low registered class. We will try to add the pattern to the book so the members will how to do it and can practise before the show.

Costume class. We have to start enforcing the rules. If they are bareback they have to wear a helmet and must be wearing regulation boots if they are on the horse.
