Cow–Calf Beef Production

If you are taking one of the Alberta 4-H beef animal projects either steer or heifer, you can also earn significant high school credits. The career pathway already exists through the green certificate program in most schools.

To summarize the program, participants receive a training curriculum representing the skills needed to obtain the Green Certificate. The trainee receives most of his or her training through apprenticeship-like, on-the-job training under a competent trainer-farmer.
