The Green Certificate Program

The Green Certificate Program provides students with opportunities to enter a variety of agriculture-related, structured learning pathways as a part of their senior high school program and to earn credential leading to a career in agribusiness.

Thus students learn on the job, under the direction of experienced farm personnel, the 4-H leader, the supervision and administration of AAFRD and Alberta Education making this the ideal partnership between the school, Alberta Agriculture and Food and 4-H. All the elements, curriculum, instruction, monitoring and evaluation are already in place.

The Green Certificate courses enable Alberta senior high school students to earn 16 senior high school credits by enrolling in combinations of courses relating to one of the following specializations. These credits are at the grade 12 level
