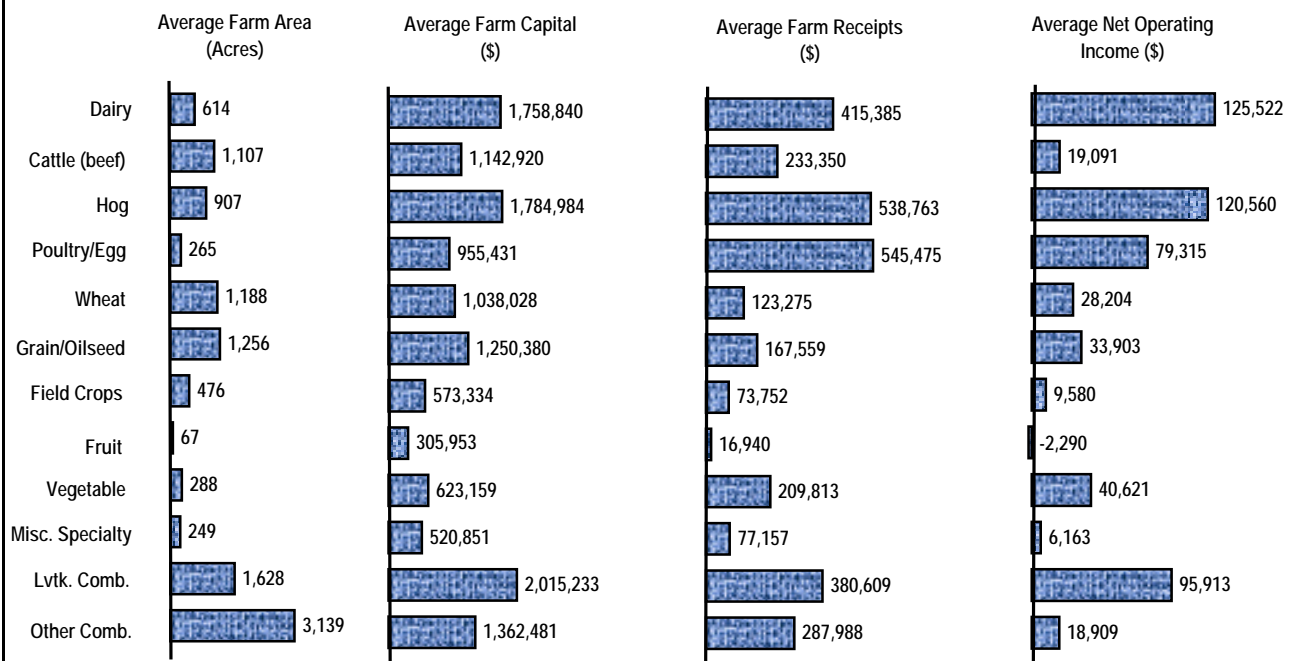

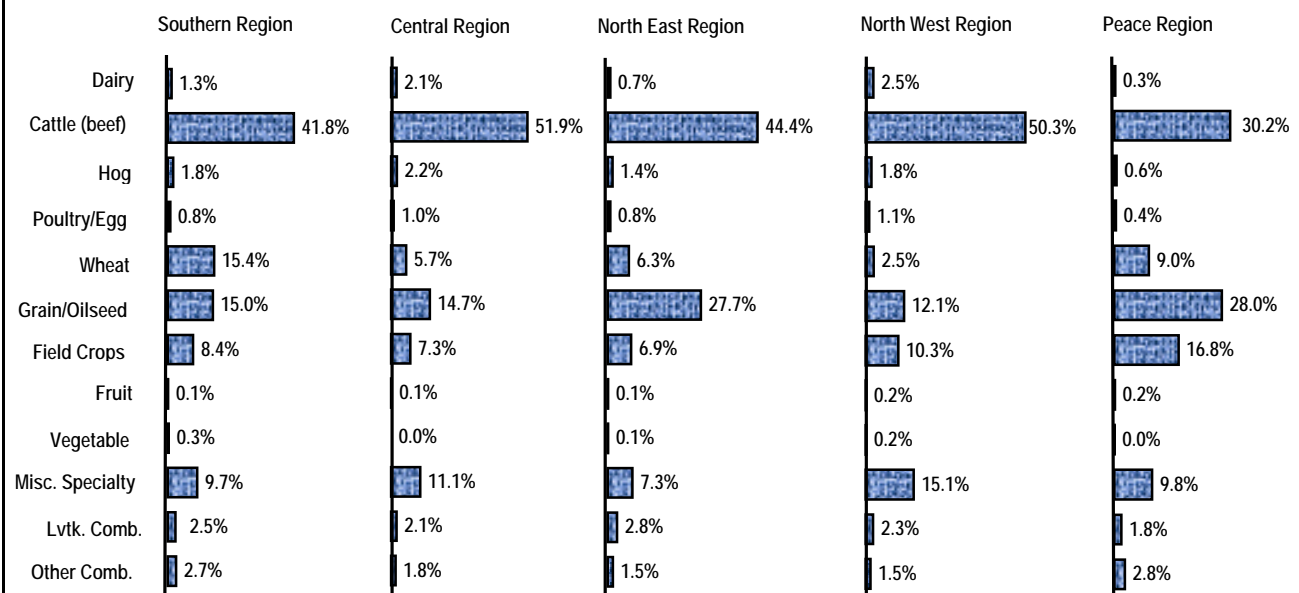

Distribution of Farms with Total Gross Farm Receipts of \$2,500 or More, Classified by Farm Type, Alberta Agricultural Regions, 2001

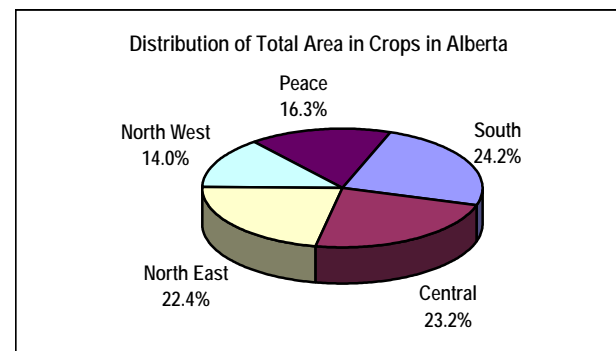
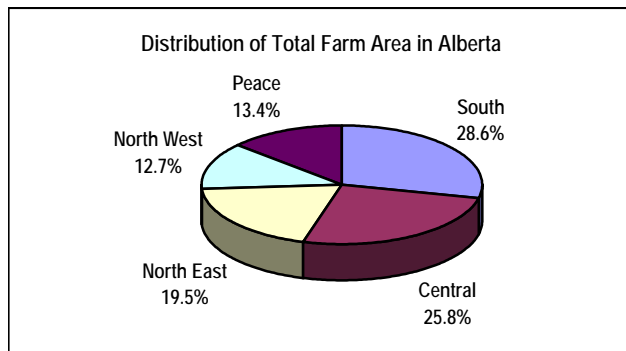
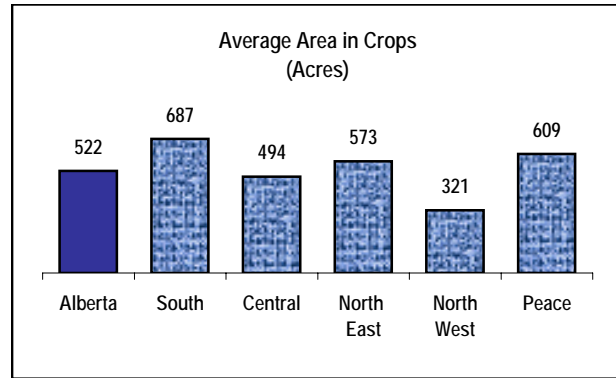
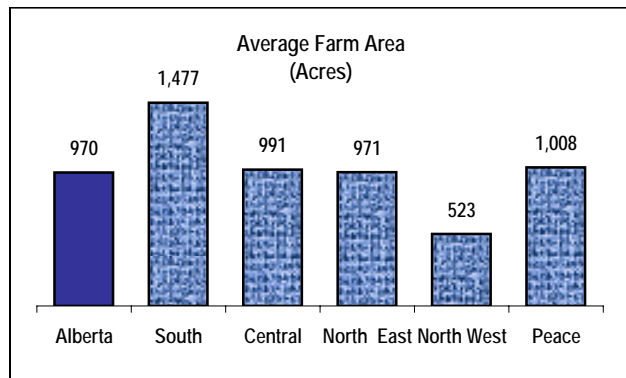

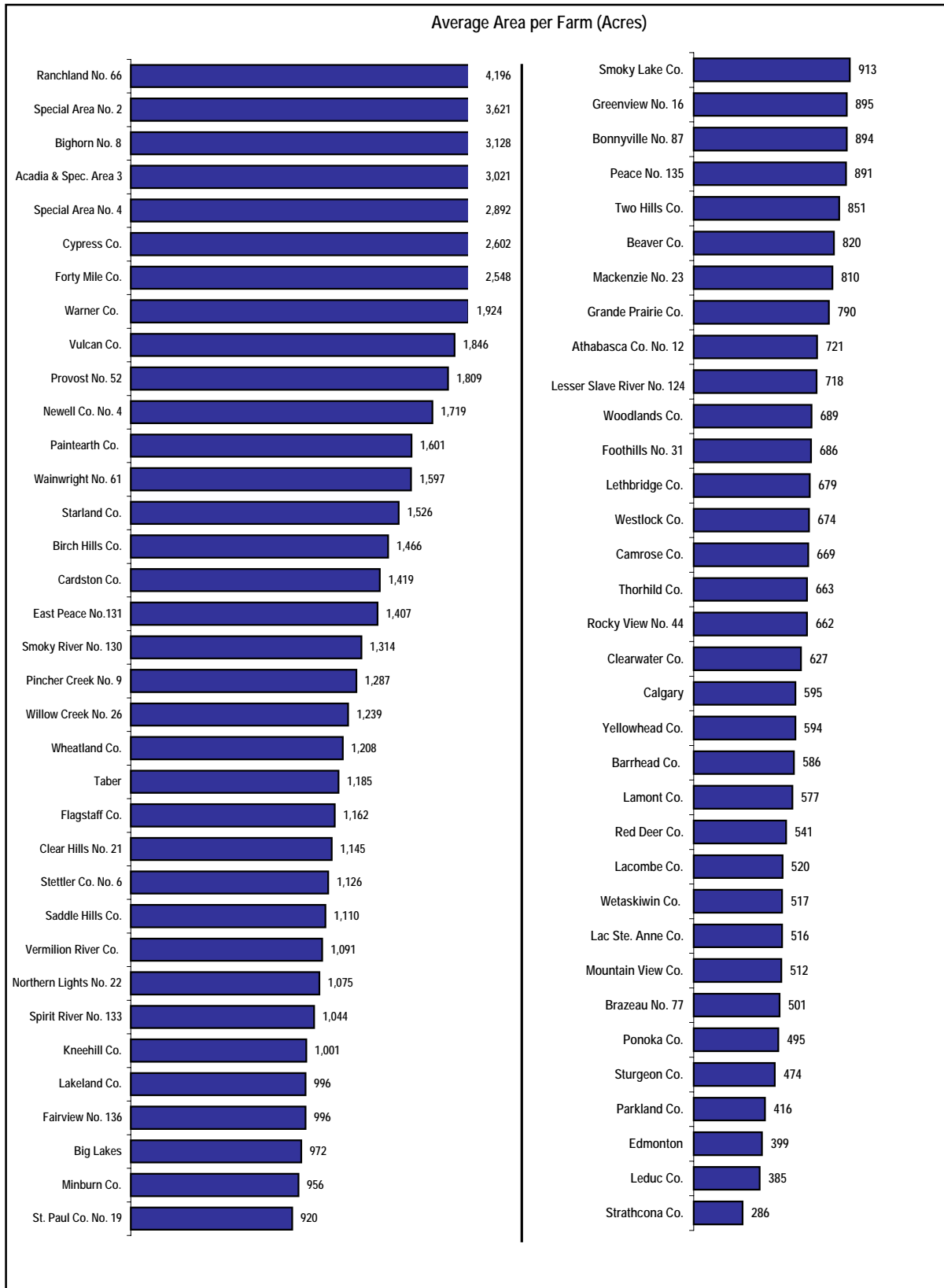

Average Farm Area per Farm by Municipality, 2001 Census of Agriculture

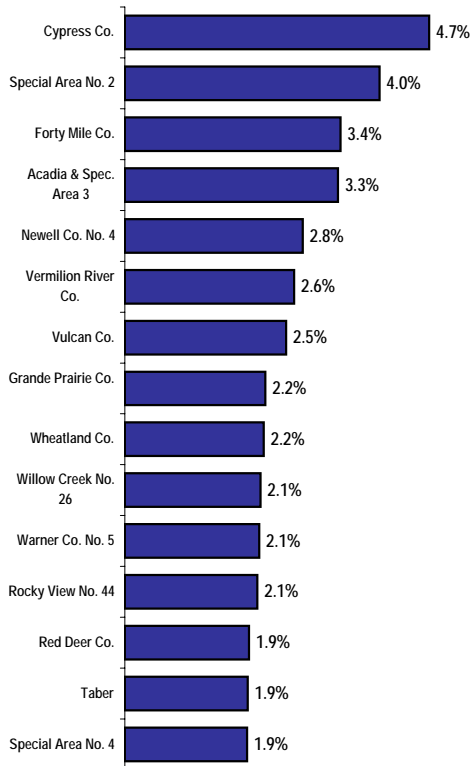

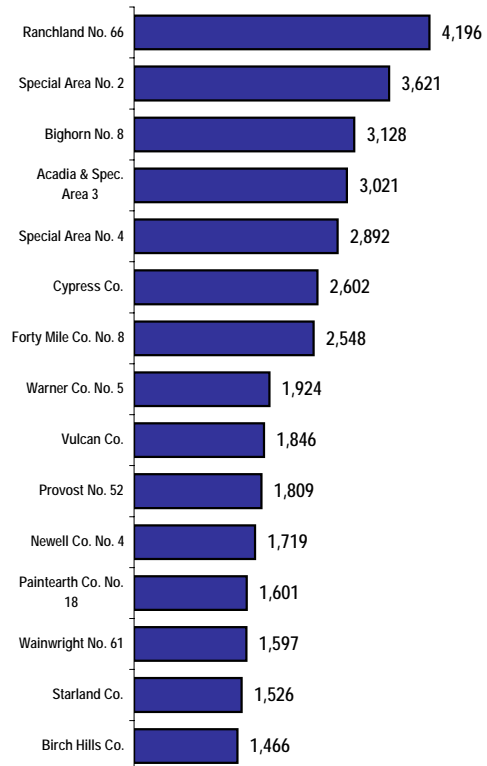

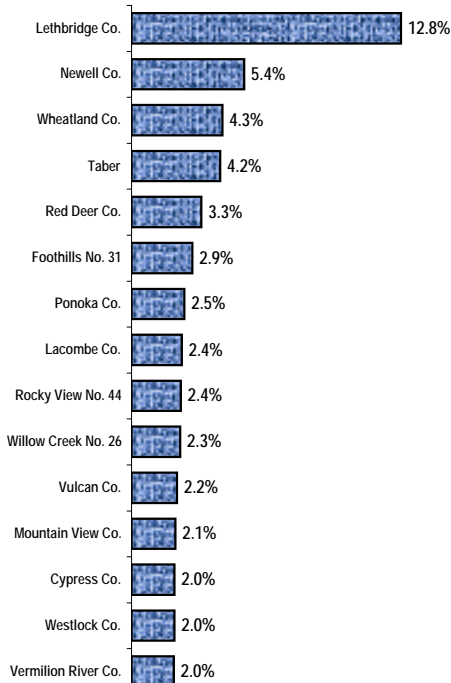
Distribution of Total Farm Area in Alberta



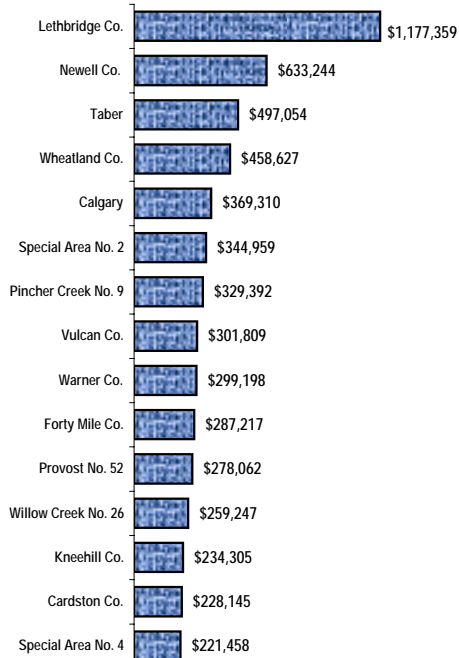
Average Farm Area (Acres)



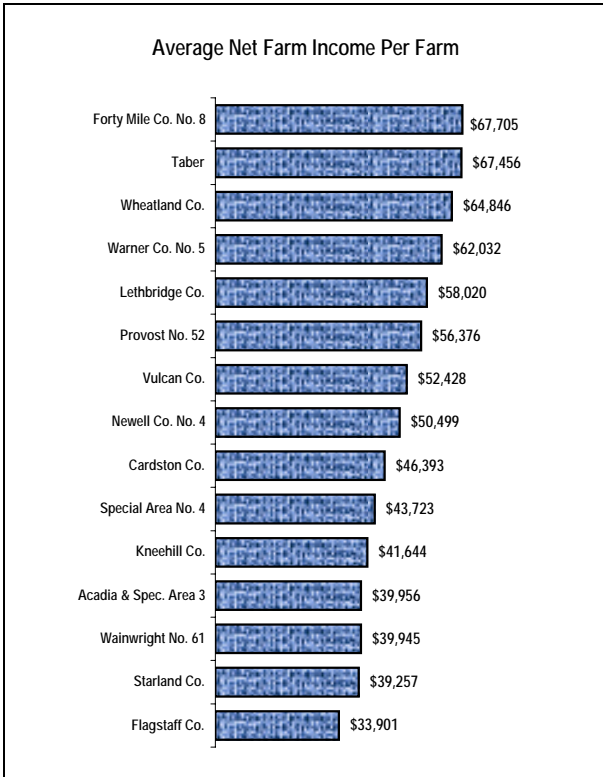
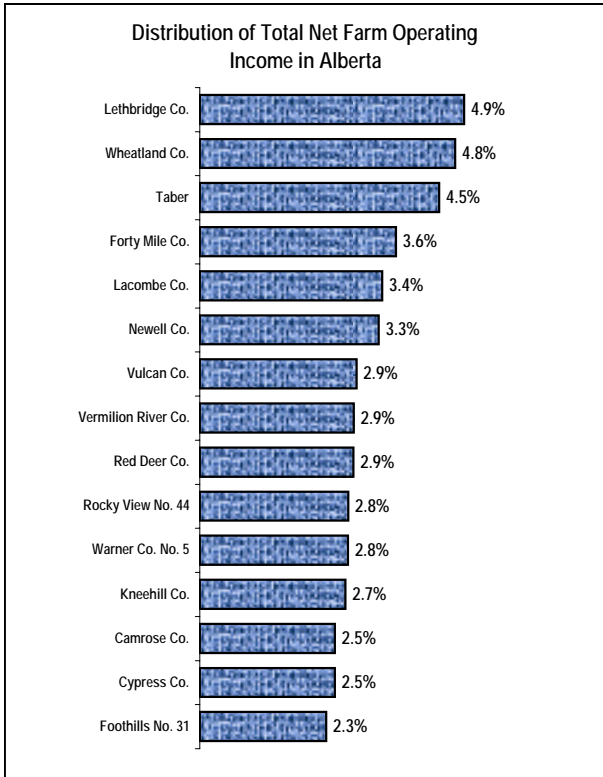
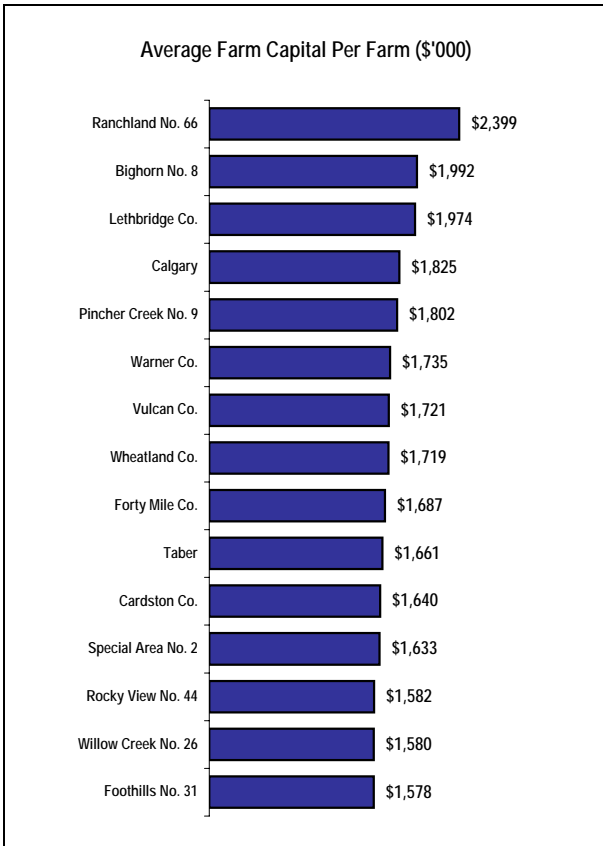
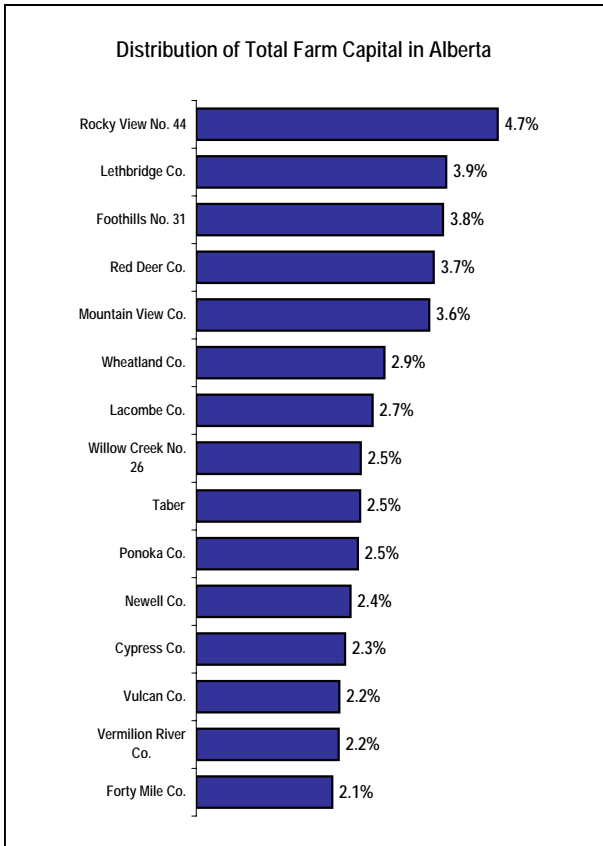
Distribution of Total Gross Farm Receipts in Alberta



Average Gross Receipts Per Farm



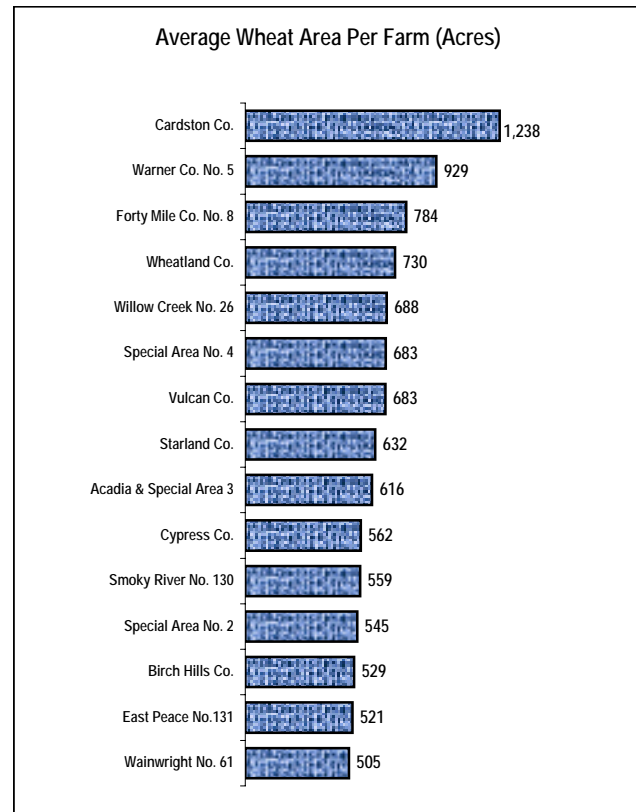
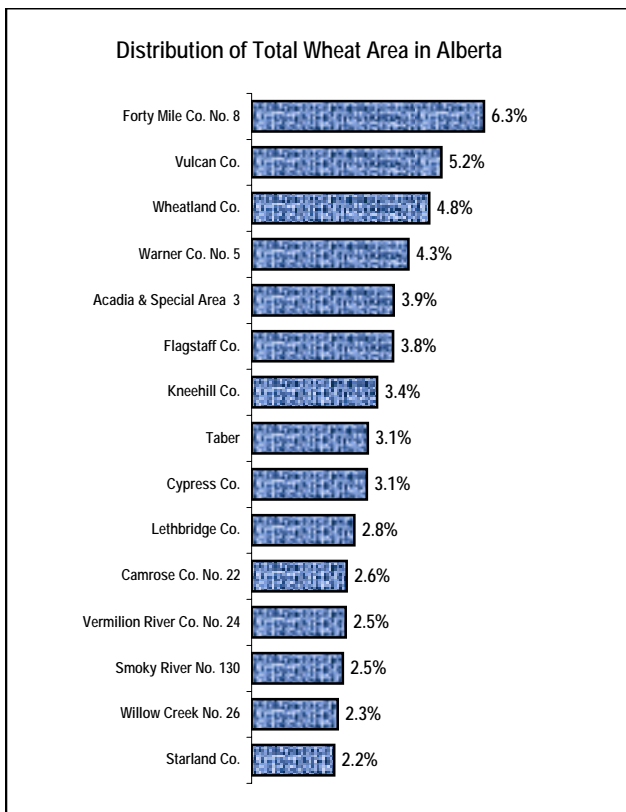
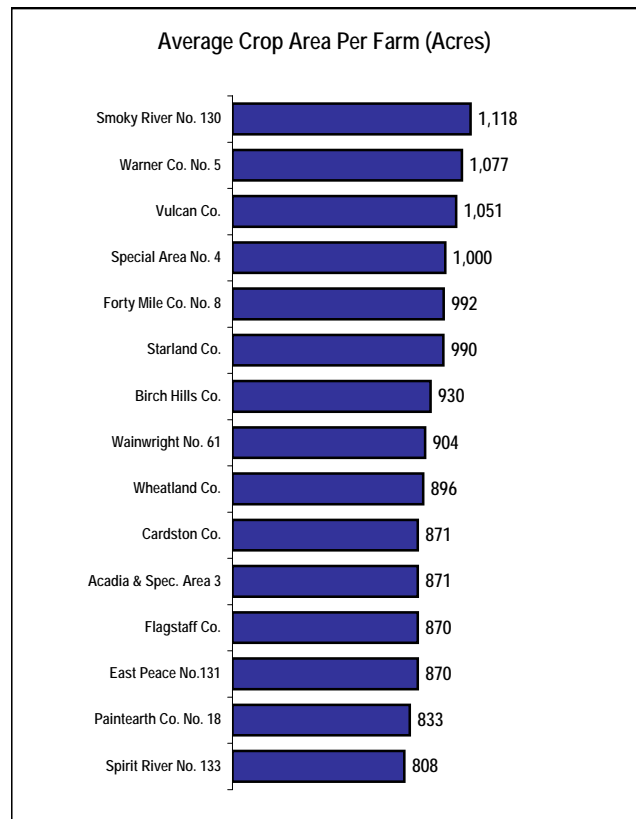
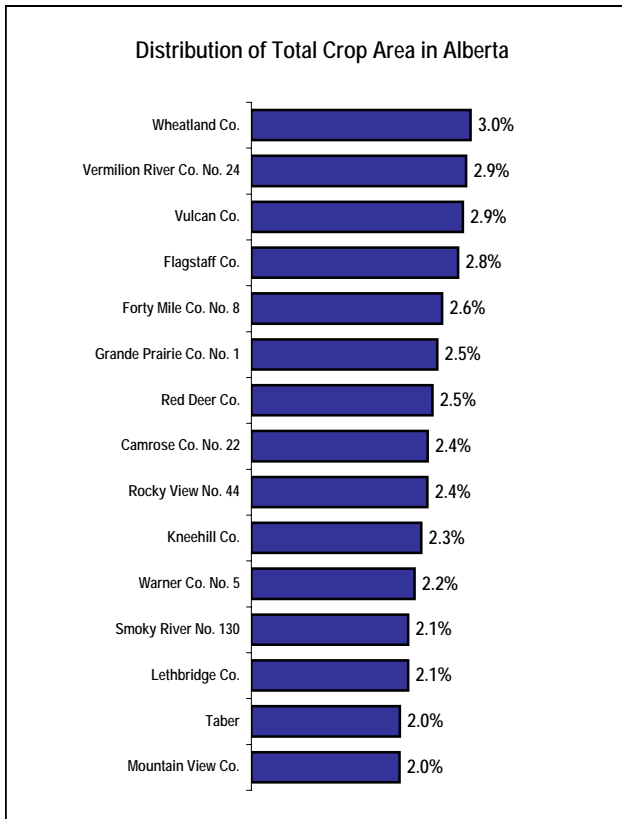

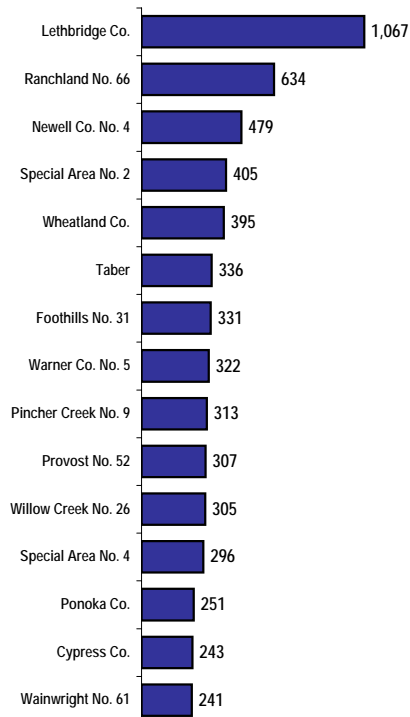

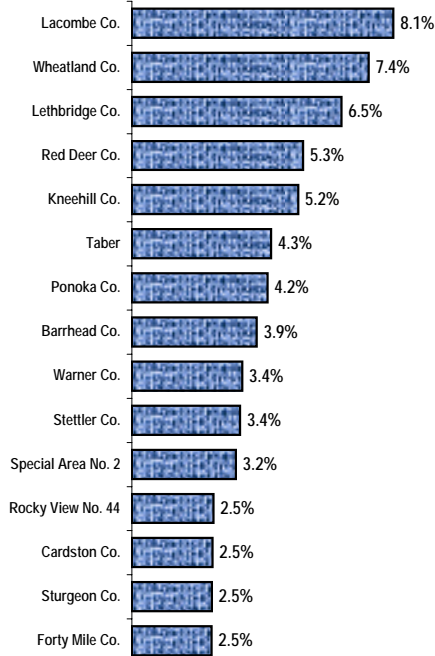
Distribution of Total Cattle & Calves in Alberta



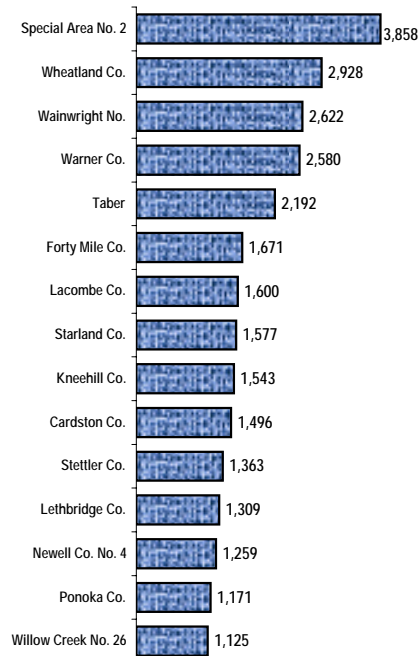
Average Number of Cattle and Calves Per Farm



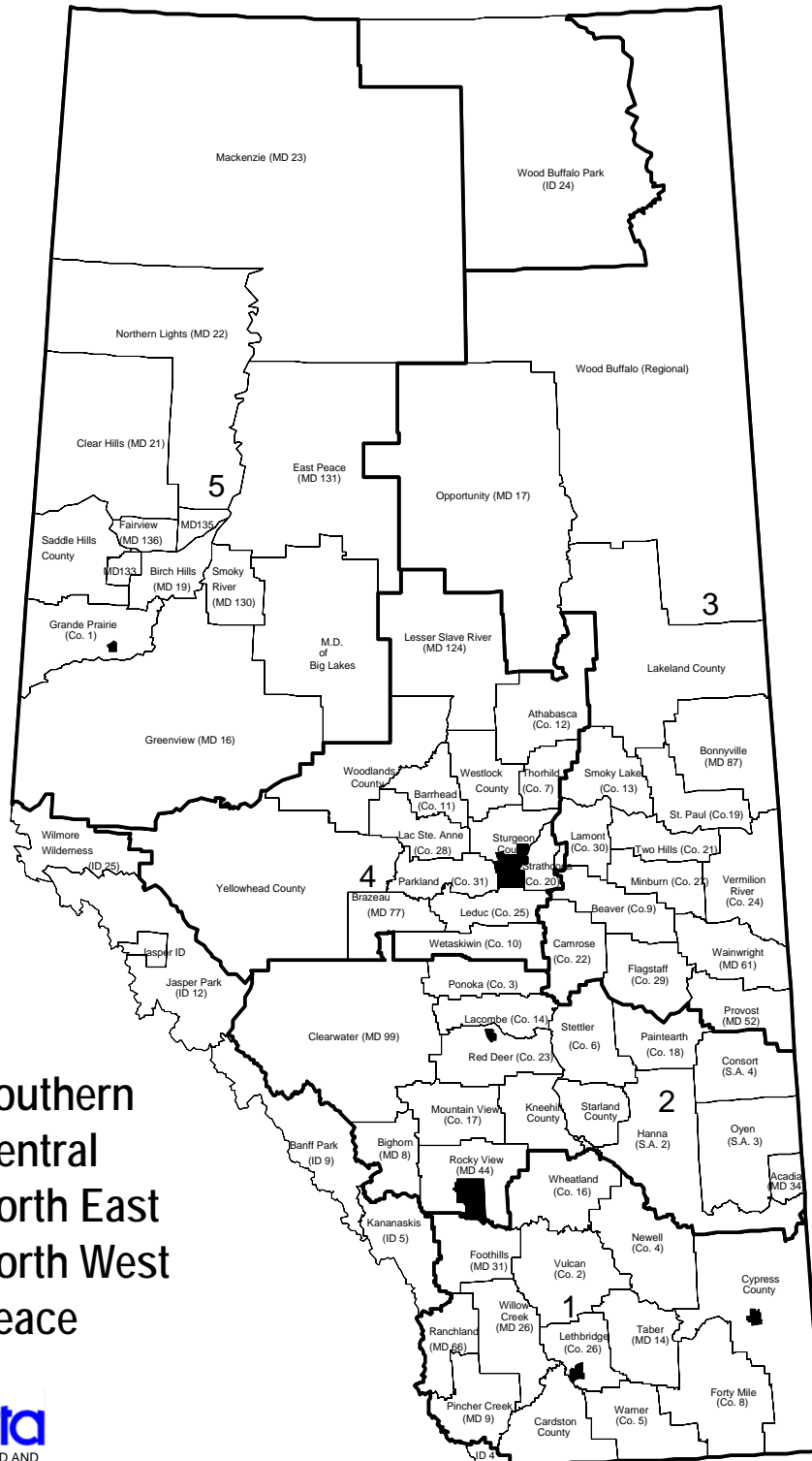
Distribution of Total Pigs in Alberta
