

POLICY 2.8 MOWING

PURPOSE:

To define a level of service for mowing in Northern Sunrise County.

SCOPE:

This policy applies to mowing in Hamlets, roadside ditches, Municipal Parks, and community areas (community halls, agricultural society grounds, cemeteries, non-municipal park areas).

POLICY:

Hamlets:

Areas in the hamlets will be mowed a minimum of three (3) times per year to ensure that Noxious Weeds and other undesirable vegetation are kept under proper management.

Roadside:

The roadside mowing program will ensure that the majority of the County roadside ditches will be done once (1) a year at one width as to comply with the *Migratory Bird Act*. Once complete, one third (1/3) of the County be fully mowed the full width of the road right-of-way twice (2) per year with no spraying, and the other two thirds (2/3) will be mowed with one pass from the shoulder of the road down. Arterial and Connector roads will be mowed the full width of the road right of way.

Municipal Parks:

Cecil Thompson Park and Harmon Valley Park will be mowed a minimum of three (3) times per year to ensure that Noxious Weeds and other undesirable vegetation are kept under proper management.

Community Groups:

From May to September, when requested, County parks maintenance employees will use County equipment to cut grass at community halls and cemeteries. A pool of one hundred twenty-five (300) manpower hours will be allocated and divided between the community halls and the agricultural society grounds. This will be done only when County resources are available.
