Purpose

To establish a process to prevent the establishment and spread of *Fusarium Graminearum* in the municipality.

Policy Statement and Guidelines

- 1. Alberta's Agricultural Pests Act is the legislative authority for enforcement of control measures for named pests in Alberta. Fusarium Graminearum, a fungus that causes the disease Fusarium Headblight (FHB,) has been declared a pest under Alberta's Agricultural Pests Act since 1999.
- 2. The Agricultural Service Board (ASB) will be responsible for the enforcement of this policy within the municipality.
- 3. The ASB will provide recommendations and information to farmers on disease prevention and control.
- 4. The ASB Department will monitor the municipality for *Fusarium Graminearum*.by conducting field surveys and will maintain records of infestations.
- 5. The ASB Department may enforce control measures as necessary to meet the objectives of the Alberta Fusarium Graminearum Management Program.
- 6. Any fields infected with *Fusarium Graminearum* will be handled by the ASB Department in accordance with Alberta's Agricultural Pests Act.
- 7. The ASB will absorb all associated costs for random sampling carried out for the purpose of monitoring.
- 8. The Landowner will be responsible for all associated costs for sampling and control measures if *Fusarium Graminearum* is found.
