**POLICY STATEMENT**

The Agricultural Service Board carries out roadside seeding where required for erosion control, aesthetics and weed control on properties under the direction of the County or as bound by agreement.

**POLICY**

The A.S.B. is responsible for seeding the ditches from the shoulder of the road to the property line on new construction and disturbed areas, controlled by Brazeau County as well as under the Weed and Erosion Control Programs. The Agricultural Service Board encourages landowners to seed their own properties. The Land Agent is responsible for informing the Director of Agriculture of the agreement between the landowner in regards to the seeding of the disturbed area on private land. If the landowner requests a forage mixture other than the standard grass mixture, it is the responsibility of the Land Agent to compensate the landowner, who in return, is responsible for purchasing and applying their own seed. The A.S.B. is responsible for seeding areas when construction has taken place in the "Green Area". The forage mixture used in the Green Area has to be acceptable to the Forestry Department.

All seed must be inspected by the Agricultural Fieldman prior to application to County properties.
