BRUSH CONTROL ON ROADSIDES

The Agricultural Fieldman will arrange the spraying of County roadsides for brush control within the guidelines as set down by the Agricultural Service Board. This spraying will be done in consultation with the Public Works Manager.

GUIDELINES:

- 1. The Public Works Department will annually prepare and submit to the Agricultural Fieldman a map and summary indicating all the previous year's road construction, brushing and back sloping.
- 2. Based on this information the Agricultural Fieldman will arrange for the spraying of brush along roadsides as required.
- 3. The Agricultural Fieldman or his designate will inspect the roads, in conjunction with a Public Works Representative, to determine their suitability for spraying and to identify other sites that need spraying.
- 4. Only trees Two (2) to Ten (10) feet in height will be sprayed. Trees of greater height are to be removed by other methods such as mechanical brushing.
- 5. A meeting between the Agricultural Fieldman and the Public Works Manager shall take place each year prior to budget consideration and at this time recommendations for the next year's budget shall be made.
- 6. The Agricultural Fieldman shall implement a brush-spraying program along roadsides in accordance with and to the extent permitted by budget allowances.
- 7. Use of Tordon 101 and Garlon 4 authorized for brush control along roadsides.
