TOPSOIL REMOVAL BY-LAW # 796

- (1) Interpretation: "TOPSOIL" - means the uppermost layer of surface layer of the soil, generally composed of partially decomposed organic matter, which may vary in depth from place to place, and does not include sand or gravel deposits.
- (2) No person shall remove topsoil from any land within the County of Camrose No. 22 unless an application for such removal has been approved and a permit issued.
- (3) The Soil Conservation Officer shall receive, consider and decide on all applications for the removal of topsoil from land.
- (4) In making a decision the Soil Conservation Officer may approve the application unconditionally or impose conditions considered appropriate, permanently or for a limited period of time, or refuse the application.
- (5) The Soil Conservation Officer may, in his discretion, suspend and reinstate or revoke any permit.
- (6) Failure of a permit holder to comply with the conditions as stipulated in Schedule A of this By-law, shall be reported to Council and result in the cancellation of the permit, and forfeiture of part or all of the performance deposit, at the discretion of Council.
- (7) The conditions as stipulated in Schedule A of this By-law.
- (8) A person who contravenes a provision of the By-law is guilty of an offense and liable to the penalties as set out in the Soil Conservation Act of Alberta, being Chapter S-19.1, 1988.

By-law No. 474 is hereby repealed.

This by-law comes into force on the day upon which it is passed.
