Seed Drill Policy

The purpose of this policy is to control the distribution and usage of the Seed Drills owned by the County of Lethbridge.

- These drills are to be used only on land located within the County of Lethbridge boundaries.
- 2. The program will be advertised annually.
- 3. A list of applicants will be kept in chronological order and distribution will be on a first come, first serve basis, as near as practical.
- 4. County personnel will arrange for movement between farms.
- 5. The onus is on the user to service, clean and maintain the drill(s) before they are returned to the County and passed on to the next applicant.
- 6. The applicant will provide a suitable tractor and a competent operator.
- 7. Cooperators will be assessed a per acre user fee as per the County of Lethbridge Schedule of Fees By-Law.
- 8. The program will be evaluated each year and necessary policy changes will be implemented at that time.
