PURPOSE AND INTENT

To provide shelterbelt trees to all County ratepayers.

POLICY STATEMENT

To promote the establishment of shelterbelts in the County.

GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

- All tree applications shall be made through Alberta Agriculture and County Agricultural Services Department.
- Where the complete order is not received, the balance will be delivered the following year.
- All cancelled orders will be dealt with by Alberta Nurseries Ltd.
- Notification of the dates of pick-up will be sent to each applicant by Alberta Nurseries Ltd. Pick-up will be limited to two days only, with one of the days being an evening to facilitate pick-up after working hours. If, for some reason, pick-up cannot be made on these days, the applicant is responsible to let the County Agricultural Services Department know and make arrangements to have someone else make the pick-up for the applicant.
- Any trees leftover will be distributed at the discretion of the County Agricultural Services Department.
