Subject:	ROADSIDE SEEDING	Control Code:	11.06

Purpose:

The broadcast seeding of grass and/or legume mixtures onto freshly backsloped roadsides, newly constructed roads, and borrow pits for the purposes of ground stabilization and weed control.

Definitions:

“Borrow Pit” – an excavation dug to provide fill to make up ground elsewhere.

Policy Statement:

1. The Agricultural Service Board will undertake a program of seeding grass and/or legume mixtures onto freshly backsloped, or newly constructed roads and borrow pits.
2. Camrose County Public Works will supply the locations, and if special varieties are required within specific areas to the Agricultural Service Board during the year of construction.
3. The Agricultural Fieldman, at his discretion, may supply an appropriate amount of grass seed to landowners wishing to seed borrow pits and roadsides on their own.
