AGRICULTURAL FIELDMAN:

To administer and implement programs that are approved by the Agricultural Service Board that will benefit the agricultural community and also to act as a Regulatory Officer in respect to the above mentioned Acts.

Other Responsibilities: Administer the:

- * Roadside Backsloping Program
- * Roadside Seeding and Mowing Program
- * Roadside Spraying Program
- * Beaver Flood Control Program
- * Pesticide Container Sites
- * Landfill Sites
- * Tours and Field Days
- * Land Reclamation
- * Seed Plant Inspections and Licensing
- * Subdivisions
- * Fire Guardian
- * Director of Disaster Services
- * Fire Department Coordinator

He will also:

- Maintain a Pesticide Applicators License for the appropriate classes.
- Have a Pesticide Dispenser Certificate (only if the County is selling pesticides).
- Maintain his Form B Certificate from Alberta Agriculture to handle restricted and controlled devices and materials which are available to livestock producers for their Coyote Predation problems (only after proper training from the Agricultural Fieldman).
- Maintain his A.A.A.F. Membership in good standing.
