

SOIL CONSERVATION SHELTERBELT POLICY

- Maximum twelve miles per year.

 If filled up, a person can use equipment after the first twelve people and/or miles are done.
- Maximum one mile of single row or equivalent per Landowner, per year.
- Applications taken on a first come, first serve basis.
- The Landowner will be charged a \$25.00 Application Fee, plus \$2.00/Bundle for the first ten and \$1.00/Bundle thereafter for transportation costs.
- New roads built by the County It is up to the Landowner to apply and conform to the above Policy.
- The County will supply Herbicide and Sprayer. The Sprayer will be taken to the field, calibrated and ready for use. The Landowner will supply the tractor and manpower.
- The County will encourage fall application of Treflan.
- The Shelterbelt must be at a distance of seventy-five feet minimum from the property line.
- The County will supply the Tree Planter and one person. The Landowner will supply the tractor and one other person.
- The County will lend out the Insecticide Sprayer free of charge for insect control for Field Shelterbelts under this Policy. (Must leave \$50.00 Damage Deposit.)
- County will inspect Shelterbelt after one year.

The County will supply:

- 1 300 Gallon Water Tank
- 1 600 Gallon Water Tank
- 2 Tree Planters
- 1 Herbicide Sprayer
- 1 Insecticide Sprayer
