

This is one day workshop. It is a highly specialized subject for commercial beekeepers and agronomists. Alberta's Pedigreed Hybrid Canola seed production continues to grow. These hybrid canola varieties are taking over traditional open-pollinated ones. In recent years Canadian canola acreage planted to hybrids has been growing. In order to meet the market needs, more acres are annually devoted for the production of pedigreed hybrid canola seeds.

In order to secure steady a supply of pedigreed hybrid canola, healthy bees are required for pollination. This workshop focuses on management practices for preparing healthy bees for pollination, best management practices for protection of bees from pesticides and honey bee nutrition.
