BY-LAW NO. 789

MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF PEACE NO. 135

Pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 1980 and amendments thereto.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipal District of Peace No. 135, Province of Alberta deems it necessary to control noxious weeds on public properties under their control, and

WHEREAS, landowners may object to the spraying of noxious weeds on public properties adjacent to their land, by the Municipality, its employees or agents.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipal District of Peace No. 135, Province of Alberta; pursuant to section 160 (1)(c) of the Municipal Government Act enacts as follows:

1. A landowner objecting to the spraying of chemicals on public properties adjacent to his land; shall be responsible for the control of noxious weeds, using methods as directed by the Municipal District of Peace No. 135.
2. The Agriculture Fieldman appointed by the Council of the Municipal District of Peace No. 135, is hereby empowered to direct the method and timing for control of noxious weeds on public properties where a landowner objects to chemical control.
3. A landowner who does not accept the direction of method and timing for the control of noxious weeds on public properties adjacent to his lands where said landowner has requested chemical spray not be used, and therefore does not carry out the Agriculture Fieldman's directive; shall then have public lands adjacent to his land sprayed with chemicals as deemed necessary by said Agriculture Fieldman.

This by-law shall come into force and effect upon the date of its final passing.

Received first and second reading and by unanimous consent of the Councillors present a third reading and finally passed this 3rd day of July, A.D. 1984.
