What is CAIPP?

The Commercial Angus Identification and Performance Program (CAIPP) is an initiative based on our Angus Tag program to provide pedigree and performance data to commercial producers that they can use to make selection decisions and market their cattle. The program is designed to enable producers to record pedigree and performance information on crossbred cattle and to record feeder calf performance at the farm, feedlot, and packing plant. Producers will have access to Parent Verification, Animal Records, Performance Endorsements, a Sire Summary, and In-Herd Indexes of calves as shown below.

Commercial Pedigree & Performance Record

Includes information about an animal's pedigree and any performance data that is available.
