With more than 440 established clubs across the province, you can be part of 4-H wherever you live. Members are between the ages of 9 and 20, and leaders must be 18 or older.

Meetings are held once or twice a month for participants to share knowledge, socialize and build friendships. In addition, many clubs take part in community events and recreational activities.

THE 4-H BENEFIT

According to the "Measures of Success" Survey conducted by Ipsos Reid:

31% of alumni have completed a university degree, certificate or diploma compared to 16% nation-wide

59% of alumni have a household income over \$50,000 compared to 45% nation-wide

85% of alumni recommend membership.

88% of leaders surveyed say the key goals and objectives of 4-H are relevant to today's youth
