Steer purchases – Stacy Murray has had a conversation with Bruce Banks of the 4-H Foundation of Alberta regarding concerns he's hearing from sponsors and from clubs. Bruce would like some input as to the messaging to take to sponsors and to share with clubs when the members/leaders/ parents are promoting the sales. Would like to discuss other options for the traditional sale – for example, order buying.

Carey asked if there are specific concerns.

Stacy commented that some of the larger sponsors, such as John Deere are looking for different ways to support 4-H than purchasing a steer and supporting one member – the "correct" member. How do they support all 4-H members with all types of projects? Another question is how to distribute funds to clubs and/or districts? There needs to be a discussion to facilitate a more equitable way sponsors/buyers can support 4-H.

Action: Stacy will set up a conference call with Bruce and BAC to discuss this topic and to provide some input as to the messaging around Achievement Day sales.

Meat graders

 There has been a restriction as to their hours of operation. Tours will be limited to weekdays only no weekends.
