

Subscription Sales Instruction Sheet

Length of Subscription Drive	• March 1 to June 16, 2006.
How It Works	 Members sell as many one year subscriptions as they can for \$32 each. \$7 is retained by the club and the remaining \$25 submitted to Western Horse Review. Subscription Price to Customer: \$32 (including GST per yearly subscription). Submit to Western Horse Review: \$25. Profit for 4H Club: \$7 per subscription.
Details	 Each subscription form remitted, must be filled out completely and payment of \$32 collected by the member. One cheque from the club (representing a payment of \$25 for each subscription remitted), is acceptable as a payment for an entire set of subscripton orders. Please do not send cash. MC/VISA orders are accepted. Western Horse Review will process the charge accounts and return to the club, a cheque representing \$7 from each charge order. Subscriptions must be tallied and postmarked to Western Horse Review in four consecutive batches, by these dates: March 31, April 30, May 31, June 30. Enclose all subscriptions and payment(s) in an envelope and mail to Western Horse Review, Bay 114, 3907–3A St. NE, Calgary, AB. Members may sell subscriptions to existing Western Horse Review subscribers in support of the program. Existing subscriptions will merely be extended for one year.
Prizes	 Results will be tallied on a monthly basis as orders come in from the clubs. The final tally will be completed by July 15, and the prizes will be sent out to each club promptly. For the club awarded the grand prize – a day clinic with Clay Webster – arrangements will be made with Clay to find a suitable time to hold the clinic. Clay will travel to the club's arena of choice and a full day clinic will be conducted. Discussions on what area of training the members would like to focus on, and a format for the day's activities, will be formulated ahead of the clinic date.


