In the 4-H Level Assessments, what level has your rider(s) completed? Check all that apply.




What discipline does your rider(s) ride?




Does your club currently have a policy on helmet use?


Would a mandatory helmet use policy affect future activities, club or events in your club, district or region?


Would you withdraw from 4-H if there was a mandatory helmet use policy?
