West Central

Our last meeting was January 22 in Lacombe. The main objective is organizing the Regional Horse Show. There are always changes being made to the order of events, rules, etc. We are adding a Ranch Horse Pleasure class for those in levels 4-7 as an alternative to Reining. Jobs were assigned for the planning of the show. It will be May 31-June 2 at the Westerner in Red Deer. Again, English will be on Friday, Western on Saturday and games on Sunday.

There are several club level events being organized including an open Equitation and Rail clinic on February 16th (Leslieville Trail Trotters), an open trail clinic on April 13th (lesslieville Trail Trotters), a 4-H show in Benalto on May 5th (Shadow Riders) and a 4-H show May 11th Shadow Riders).

Regional Training Event – TRAIL CLINIC; held in Lacombe on January 26 with over 30 leaders and senior members attending. This was a classroom educational clinic on how to judge and score trail classes. It was hosted by Janet Kerr with Dwayne Grover instructing. Attendees were given trail score sheets (AQHA), trail patterns, regional rules and a few informative handouts and then told how a judge scores each trail obstacle. They watched a few trail video clips from shows and saw the scoring differences between a -1 ½ to a +1 ½ maneuver on the trail courses. Then they were given the opportunity to score a rider in a class. After 1 ½ hrs on trail there was another hour or so on scoring horsemanship and showmanship classes using the same format. It was felt by most leaders that they learned a lot about how show classes are scored and hoped we could continue to host these, educating them on other judged classes (ie., English, etc.)

A questionnaire was circulated regarding the lack of participation in the regional clinics. Only about half of them were returned and according to those we had 9 who signed up and there were 2 who didn't fill out a form who also signed up. Three who didn't sign up. Those who didn't had timing issues or didn't know about it. Some found the online form difficult and would rather have called in to register. Others thought that the clinics were all full according to the graph on the online registration.

Our next meeting will be February 19th in Lacombe at 7:30.

5. Provincial Horse Show

Provincial 4-H Horse Show Report - Feb. 12, 2013

Our committee took part in a conference call on Dec. 10th to discuss this year's horse show. It was decided to stay with the same format as in previous years with some changes.

- Entries will be on line. Entrants will have the option of scanning the attachments for mailing them in postmarked no later than the deadline date, which has be changed to June 15th instead of June 20th.
- Move in will be Friday, Aug. 2nd after 3:00 pm with a parent/member meeting in the Megadome bleachers at 8:00 pm that evening.
- The show will run from Sat., Aug. 3 to Mon., Aug 5 with the Parade of Clubs, English, Dressage, Handy Horse & Jumping on Sat.; Western, Trail & Reining on Sun.; Gymkhana on Monday.
- We will be awarding cash prizes for 1st to 3rd place and ribbons to 6th place all three days.
- There will still be a High Point and Reserve High Point award for Level 4, 5 & 6/7 on the English & Western Days, but on Gymkhana Day, we will be dividing the participants into teams and we will award a Team High Point award. ω
- For jumping, we are going to replace the Open Jumping class with a Gambler's Choice class.
- There will be two Dressage tests for the riders to choose from for their class.
- We will be using Reining Pattern No. 10 for reining. Do we want a different one for Jr. Horse?
- We will be replacing the Thread the Needle class with the Big T class this year for Gymkhana.
- We are changing the order of classes this year to have each Level's Pleasure class followed by their Equitation/Horsemanship class so that they will have more time to go to their other classes in the Caluori.
- We have eliminated the Command classes.
- We will not be having any Yearling or 2Yr. old classes this year because of the lack of entries over the last 2 years.
