Before You Get Started

	Remember you are always representing Alberta 4-H!
	Be sure to dress 4-H appropriate.
	Wearing layered clothing is a good idea no matter the location.
	Wear comfortable footwear.
	Set up your booth before the tradeshow starts. Being late is never a good idea!
	Make sure you have enough "4-H Power" to work the booth. For an all day event have at LEAST three people and work in shifts so you can take turns taking breaks.
	If possible, invest in some cushioned mats to stand on. They will save your feet, legs and back!
	Make sure you have all your promotional material ahead of time.
W	hile at Your Booth

hile at Your Booth		
Pay attention to details:		
	Straight table cloth	
	Materials appropriately stocked and organized	
	Make sure the display is always positioned at the most visible angle within the booth	
	Put your table at the back or side of your booth when possible - this helps open up the booth to visitors	
	Try to have something interactive that people can put their hands on – games, etc.	
If you choose to sit at a booth be sure to appear alert and enthusiastic to speak to visitors. Always stand to talk to people and use personal experience and stories to explain points.		
Don't be afraid to say that you don't know the answer to a question. Just take down the person's name and contact information and tell them you will have someone get back to them with the answer.		
Be an active listener.		
Whenever possible DO NOT:		
	Eat at the booth	
	Text or talk on cell phones	
	Listen to MP3s or IPods	
	Leave the booth unattended	

Last of all Remember to smile and have fun! Show everyone why 4-H is so great!
