Hi, my name is Hunter Kulik, I am four years old. Every third Sunday I go for a blood transfusion for 3-4 hours because I have a rare blood disorder called Diamond Blackfan Anemia which causes my body to not produce red blood cells.

Did you know that there are not a lot of funds available for rare disorders? Did you know that Alberta Health care does not pay for all of the medical supplies required for treatment that is needed to save our lives? Medical supplies need include needles, pumps, tape, alcohol swabs and Tegaderm which can add up to over \$100.00 a month.

Please come to the WICHA Ladies' Day out to raise money for the Hunter's Fight For a Cure Foundation of Alberta so I can help other children that suffer from the same disorder.
