

Application for a Class “C” Commercial Fish Culture Licence

Thank you for applying to become a commercial fish culturist. A Commercial Class “C” Fish culturist must possess a current license for fish to be held or harvested for a fee, or sold to the public, but all fish must be dead before being removed from the premises. A Class “C” license is \$100.00 annually. Licenses will be issued for a term expiring on the following March 31. Following are a few items to assist you in completing this form.

- Commercial “C” Fish Culturist License relates to a co-operative water body on privately owned land. The species allowed for this license are listed on the top of Page 1 of the application.
- More than one water body may be covered under a license if they are within 640 contiguous acres (one square mile).
- Be advised that using water for the culture of fish may require a license under the **Water Act**. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure biological, engineering, land and water use permits have been obtained.

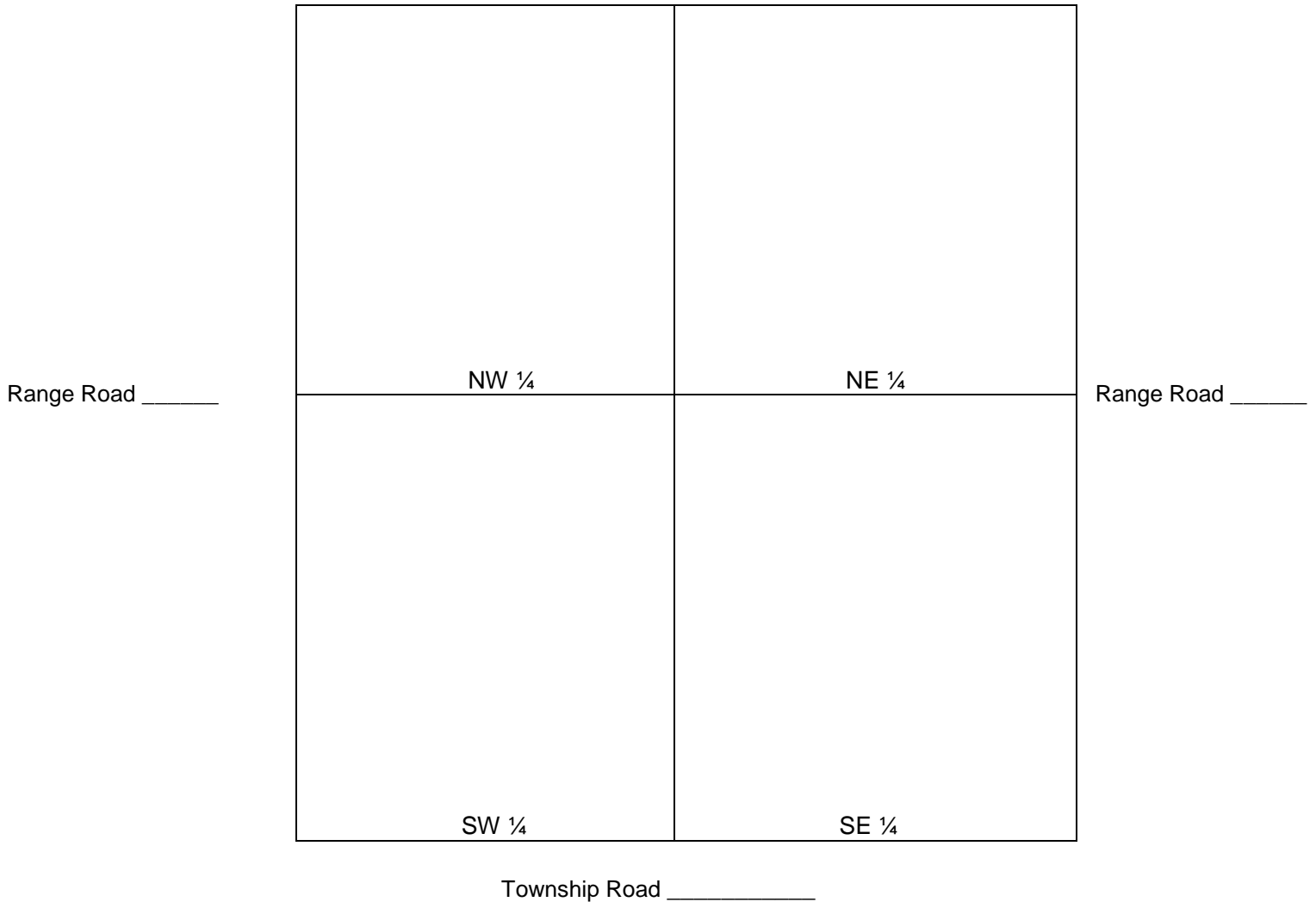

Include a complete drawing of the water bodies and/or facilities that you are applying to have licensed, **SHOWING DRAINAGE**, overflow areas and other nearby lakes, sloughs or streams (include all water control structures - dams, weirs, etc.). Indicate all public roads, road allowances, and the location of your residence (if it is near the site). All new commercial fish farm applications require on-site inspection. Sites will normally be inspected in the spring when they are ice-free and all drainage is visible. PLEASE ENSURE YOU INDICATE NORTH with an arrow.
