



Abattoir Agreement

By agreeing to participate:

- All participating abattoirs will accept and process beef
- All abattoirs with the exception of Ben's Quality
 Meats Ltd. will accept and process pork
- Beef and pork will be processed into ground product
- Beef will be twice ground at 1/8 inch and pork will be twice ground at 3/16 inch
- Ground product will be packaged in 2lb units, and will be traceable according to industry standard
- Interfaith Food Bank will be responsible for transportation of ground product from participating abattoir

Abattoir Agreement

- Pork donations will be distributed to abattoir in batches of five unless alternative arrangements have been made.
 Pork donations will not exceed 470lb live weight
- All invoices from abattoirs will be mailed to Interfaith Food Bank Society of Lethbridge
- In the instance of a condemned animal, invoice will be mailed to Interfaith Food Bank and the food bank will collect reimbursement of condemnation fees from producer
- All pricing is located in the table below and is subject to GST
- Pricing will be reassessed bi- annually in January and June
- You agree to be promoted as a participating abattoir
- You agree to display Project Protein promotional material at your location



Options

Sponsorships

Platinum: \$5000 per year. This elite sponsorship opportunity allows your company logo to be stamped on all ground beef or pork products distributed from Interfaith Food Bank Society of Lethbridge. Platinum sponsorship will also include special recognition at our annual Friends of Interfaith Charity Dinner & Silent Auction. You will also receive all gold recognition sponsorship opportunities.

Gold: \$3000 per year. This sponsorship opportunity includes your company logo on our sponsorship plaque that is located above the meat freezer at Interfaith Food Bank Society of Lethbridge. You will also receive all silver recognition sponsorship opportunities.

Silver: \$2000 per year. This sponsorship opportunity involves your company logo on all promotional material related to Project Protein as well as a public service announcement to local media outlining your involvement in the project. You will also receive all bronze recognition sponsorship opportunities.

Bronze. \$1000 per year. This sponsorship opportunity recognition involves your company logo on social media (+900 followers) related to Interfaith Food Bank Society of Lethbridge and Project Protein. Recognition also includes your logo acknowledgement on our Project Protein website page.

Donations

Approximate processing costs of an animal are \$500 for cattle and \$200 for pork. Donors can choose to cover the cost of processing a certain number of livestock and in return will be eligible for a charitable tax receipt.
