- Have ASB Conference evaluation done on-line

- Crop Residue is the concern not the seed
- Crop rotation and education the key

Pennycress- Mary Ann

- Food prices increasing
- o Using Pennycress as biofuel
- o Plant is easily controlled with herbicides
- o Grown on marginal land as to not to take away from productive land
- o Mary Ann will forward information to the committee
- What does this committee need to do?- tabled until next meeting

- o Introductions to the new executive
- o Talked about Provincial Key Contact model
 - Is it working in all Municipalities
 - Need to strategically look at resources to support ASB's
 - Need to have a contact with experience to understand the relationship better and working with producers
 - Ongoing discussions around key contacts to continually expand and improve

- Some ASB's want a different model
- Do an annual review

Farm Safety- Jo Ann Hall

- Requests to local ASB's to request them to pay 1/3rd of share to keep farm safety going from Alberta Farm Safety Program
 - Consolidate the funding and run one program
 - Redundant for money to go out to Ag Societies and ASB's and then to Farm Safety Centre
 - \$2500 was a promotional tool to get Ag Societies thinking about farm safety
 - Original letter did not look like it was conditional funding
 - AAAS has more positive input than negative from the funding
 - Needs more coordination

Eradicable weeds – Jim Duncan

- Resolution came forward at Provincial Conference
- Where the funding can come from started the discussion
- Funding from excess ASB funding not utilized is not acceptable with AAAF
 - Concern that it would take funding away from other good initiative already initiated
- Apply as a municipality to the Province for an allotment
- Draw up a program and present it to the Minister
- Weed Control Act and some of the weeds on the list that should not be another concern
- Whole issue needs to be part of the ASB Act review

• 2% Liquid Strychnine

- Registration came through
- Letter came from AAAF mixing has changed compared to Saskatchewan
- o Gophers out already
- When letters come out they will be forwarded to the Provincial Committee
- o MP Benoit requested extension to end of July to use product
- Deadlines need to be changed
- No evidence of any off-site targeting use to date
- Do we have to revisit this issue annually for product registration?

Weed Control Fines

- o Jim Duncan will forward letter from the Minister
- o Go to Minister and setup with RSD
- o Move forward and keep working with group
- Confusion on how it may be carried out
- Fines Act would have to be changed
- Pleased with response letter and set up a committee and start pilot project
