Agricultural Pest and Nuisance Species	May 9, 2017	No. 298/17

Purpose:

To establish a policy in accordance with the Alberta Agricultural Pest Act and Regulations in the management and control of designated agricultural pests.

Policy Statement:

Council recognizes that management and control of agricultural pests are vital to the success of the agricultural producers in Kneehill County.

Policy Guidelines/Procedures:

- 1. The ASB staff will assist as required Kneehill County agricultural producers in the management and control of agricultural pests using an integrated pest management approach.
- 2. County Council will appoint ASB personnel that are trained and authorized by Alberta Agriculture and Forestry as Kneehill County inspectors under the Alberta Agricultural Pest Act Section 10(1).
- 3. The ASB will budget for pest inspector training and certification as set out by Alberta Agriculture.
- 4. The ASB staff will have available information on best management practices for the control of declared pest and nuisance pest as designated under the Agricultural Pest Act and Regulations.
- 5. The ASB staff will participate in the distribution of pest control products recommended by Alberta Agriculture and approved by the ASB and Council.
- 6. The ASB staff where possible will make available specialized application equipment approved by the ASB and Council for the control of agriculture pests.
