By-law No. 856-84

A By-law of the County of Newell No. 4, in the Province of Alberta, to control Common and Showy Milkweed.

Whereas, Common and Showy Milkweed are not classified as weeds under the regulations of the Weed Control Act, and there is no way at present that a land owner can be compelled to control these plants growing on his property


And Whereas these plants have started showing aggressive tendencies which are making them into objects of agricultural concern in many areas of Southern Alberta and especially areas where irrigation farming is carried on, such as in the County of Newell No. 4

And Whereas the Agricultural Service Board of the County of Newell No. 4 requests that certain weeds be designated noxious weeds

Now therefore, the said Council enacts as follows: that Common Milkweed (*Asclepios Syriaca*) and Showy Milkweed (*Asclepios speciosa*) be designated noxious weeds in the County of Newell No. 4.

- Sept. 20/84 Moved by Councillor Andrews that consent of Council be given for third and final reading of By-law 856-84. Carried Unanimously.
- Sept. 20/84 Moved by Councillor Workes that By-law 856-84 receive third and final reading. Carried Unanimously.
