Policy Statement:

The Lamont County Agricultural Service Board will assist Landowners in the acquisition and distribution of Shelterbelt Trees.

Purpose: To establish shelterbelt trees in efforts to promote soil and water conservation and rural beautification.

Policy Resolution: 89-41, 95-335, ASB05-36, ASB16-042, ASB 19-012

Procedure:

- 1) Applications are to be made through the Prairie Shelterbelt Program in Sundre, Alberta; HELP International Shelterbelt Tree Program in Weyburn, Saskatchewan, and TreeTime.ca out of Edmonton, Alberta.**
- 2) Sorting and distribution is to be done by ASB staff.**
- 3) Tree orders must be picked up within the first two days of distribution or they will be redistributed at the discretion of the Agricultural Fieldman.**
- 4) The ASB tree planter is available to landowners for the establishment of shelterbelt trees on a first come first serve basis. (Refer to equipment rental policy).**
- 5) Landowners who wish to establish shelterbelts along roadside must plant them according to the General Municipal Servicing Standards.**
